- 5. Each poster must depict only <u>ONE</u> of our "12 Rules for Staying Safe". A poster that includes multiple rules will be disqualified.
- 6. All spelling and grammar must be correct in posters, or they will be disqualified.
- 7. Each entry MUST have the name of the student, age, grade and school on the back of the poster.
- 8. Posters must be oriented horizontally.
