What are e-Disbursements?

The State of Ohio offers you two ways to receive your child support payments. With Direct Deposit, your support payments are deposited directly into your bank account after the state receives and posts a payment to your case. We also offer a faster and more convenient method, which is a Debit Card Program where payments are received via a smiONE™ Visa Debit Card. With this program, payments are credited to your card automatically after the state receives and posts a payment to your case.

What is an electronic disbursement?

It is an electronic funds transfer by means of a direct deposit to a financial institution or transfer to a credit/debit card.

Is electronic disbursement an optional program?

It is not an optional program. The ODJFS Office of Child Support is required to issue support payments by means of electronic disbursement. The goal of electronic disbursement is to deliver the support monies to obligees as quickly as possible. All child support payments must be processed to a direct deposit account or to the smiONE™ Visa Debit Card.

How is the smiONE™ Visa Debit Card beneficial to child support customers?

- Payments are received in a safe, convenient and efficient manner.
- EMV chip technology.
- No traditional or existing bank account needed.
- 24/7 online account access at http://www.smionecard.com
- Cash withdrawals from the card may be made at any ATM or bank teller window displaying the Visa symbol.
- Deposits may be made onto the card from other sources.
- Can be used to pay bills online.
- Additional cards may be obtained for family members.
- The card can be used everywhere Visa Debit Cards are accepted.

How can I use my card?

Use your smiONE™ Visa Prepaid Card everywhere Visa debit cards are accepted. Withdraw cash from ATMs, banks or credit unions that display the Visa®, Interlink®, Plus®, Fifth Third Bank, or Allpoint® Brand Acceptance Marks. To withdraw cash at an ATM, enter your PIN when prompted and select "checking" to access your funds.

What can I do on the smiONE™ Mobile App?

Download the smiONE™ Mobile App for iOS or Android to activate your card, check your balance, use smiONE™ Mobile Check Load, set up smiONE™ alerts, track your spending, pay bills and more.

What fees are associated with the smiONE™ Visa Debit card?

No fees are charged if you use an Allpoint® ATM or Fifth Third Bank ATM to withdraw cash, or for any purchase transactions. A \$2.50 ATM Withdrawal Fee (out-of-network) applies to non-Allpoint® and non-Fifth Third Bank ATM withdrawals.



smiONE™ Debit Cards are mailed to the address on file with your county child support agency. Cards will not be forwarded to a different address by the post office. Therefore, it is important to keep your address updated with your county agency at all times.
