Akron Man Pleads Guilty to Shooting Man to Death

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, February 09, 2017) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Darien Mingo, 23, of Ellsworth Road in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the shooting death of 47-year-old Erick Hunt Sr.

Mingo pled guilty to the following charge:

- Involuntary Manslaughter with a Gun Specification – a felony of the 1st degree

December 19, 2015, the victim met Mingo at an apartment on West Long Street in Akron. An argument broke out and Mingo shot Hunt four times, once in the back. Hunt died at the scene.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Joy Malek-Oldfield is scheduled to sentence Mingo on March 10, 2017 at 11am.
