Cuyahoga Falls Man Pleads Guilty to Severely Injuring Infant

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, August 04, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that William Jobe, 29, of Second Street in Cuyahoga Falls, pled guilty to violently shaking his girlfriend's baby.

Jobe pled guilty to the following charges:

• Endangering Children – a felony of the 2nd degree

According to Cuyahoga Falls police, emergency crews responded to the Second Street home on August 19, 2015 after a call to 9-1-1 to report an 8-month-old who was having difficulty breathing. The 8-month-old was transported to the hospital with serious injuries. During a police interview, Jobe, who was the live-in boyfriend of the baby's mother and was home alone at the time of the incident, admitted to shaking the infant. The baby is recovering from a significant brain injury however faces a long recovery process.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Paul Gallagher is scheduled to sentence Jobe on September 7, 2016 at 10am.
