Robert Kolvek of Akron Found Guilty of Making Meth

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, December 21, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Robert Kolvek, 50, of Akron, was found guilty of several drug charges, including making meth.

On Friday, December 18, 2015, jurors found Kolvek guilty of the following charges:

- Illegal Manufacture of Drugs a felony of the first degree
- Two counts of Illegal Assembly of Drugs felonies of the third degree
- Aggravated Possession of Drugs a felony of the fifth degree

In April of 2015, Akron Police officers respond to houses on Archwood Avenue and Stanley Road following a complaint for the manufacture of methamphetamines. Investigators discovered components used to make drugs at both locations and found Kolvek was assembling and manufacturing meth. Kolvek was also found guilty of buying pseudoephedrine, a key ingredient, with the intent to manufacture meth from a business in Cuyahoga Falls in May 2015.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Thomas Parker is scheduled to sentence Kolvek on January 26, 2016 at 8:30am.
