New Franklin Man Pleads Guilty in Connection with Norton Man's Death

AKRON, Ohio (Friday, August 26, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Robert Lantz Jr., 37, of Lullaby Lane in New Franklin, pled guilty in connection with the death of a man at a Norton strip-club.

Lantz pled guilty to the following charge:

- Involuntary Manslaughter – a felony of the 1st degree

On November 19, 2015, Lantz got into a physical altercation with 63-year-old Daniel Carraway at Desiree's in Norton. After they were kicked out of the bar, Lantz attacked Carraway in the parking lot. Police arrived and found Carraway unresponsive. Carraway was taken to the hospital where he was pronounced dead.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Scot Stevenson is scheduled to sentence Lantz on October 4 at 1pm.
