Norton Woman Pleads Guilty to Robbery and Assault Involving Pit Bulls

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, May 06, 2020) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Linda Snow, 65, of South Hametown Road in Norton, pled guilty in connection to a robbery at an ACME Market and an assault on a store employee.

Snow pled guilty to the following charges:

- Aggravated Robbery – a felony of the 1st degree
- Felonious Assault – a felony of the 2nd degree

On August 16, 2019, Snow and her daughter, Jennifer Clark, stole a cart full of food from the ACME Market food store on East Avenue in Akron's Kenmore neighborhood. When an ACME employee confronted Snow and Clark in the parking lot, Snow opened the doors of her vehicle where there were three pit bull dogs. Two of the dogs attacked the store employee, who suffered serious injuries. Snow, Clark, Clark's 11-year-old son, and the dogs, then drove off.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Kathryn Michael is scheduled to sentence Snow on July 9, 2020 at 3pm.

On January 29, 2020 Jennifer Clark, 38, of LaCroix Avenue in Akron, pled guilty to the following charges:

- Robbery – a felony of the 3rd degree
- Endangering Children – a misdemeanor of the 1st degree

Judge Michael is scheduled to sentence Clark on May 27, 2020 at 9am.
