### **Akron Man Pleads Guilty in Mother's Death**

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, May 29, 2018) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Michael Gleisinger, 49, of Crystal Street in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the stabbing death of his 78-year-old mother Nancy Gleisinger.

Gleisinger pled guilty to the following charges:

- Involuntary Manslaughter – a felony of the 1<sup>st</sup> degree
- Failure to Provide for a Functionally Impaired Person – a felony of the 4<sup>th</sup> degree

On May 16, 2017, Michael Gleisinger stabbed his mother, Nancy, to death. Nancy Gleisinger suffered from Alzheimer's disease at the time of the incident. Michael, who was his mother's full-time caregiver, has suffered from mental health issues for much of his life. Michael recently spent time at the Northcoast Behavioral Healthcare System.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Alison Breaux is scheduled to sentence Gleisinger on Tuesday June 26, 2018 at 1pm.
