## **Akron Man Convicted of Kidnapping & Robbery**

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, May 14, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that jurors found Dequante Moorer, 21, of Grace Avenue in Akron, guilty of breaking into a home, tying up a victim, and stealing a flat screen television and home theater system.

Moorer was found guilty of the following charges:

- Kidnapping a felony of the first degree
- Aggravated Burglary a felony of the first degree
- Robbery a felony of the second degree

On December 18, 2012, Moorer was one of five men who broke into a home on Beck Avenue in Akron. They tied up one of the residents with duct tape and stole a 52-inch television and home theater system. DNA found on the duct tape and a napkin matched Moorer's.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Christine Croce will sentence Moorer on May 20, 2015 at 8:45 am.
