New Franklin Woman Pleads Guilty in Crash Which Killed Two Teens

AKRON, Ohio (Friday, March 30, 2018) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Natasha Boggs, 25, of Weaver Road in New Franklin, pled guilty in connection with a deadly crash that killed two teens and left a third severely injured.

Boggs pled guilty to the following charges:

- Two Counts of Involuntary Manslaughter felonies of the 3rd degree
- Vehicular Assault a felony of the 4th degree
- Attempted Tampering with Evidence a felony of the 4th degree

On May 28, 2017, Boggs was driving on South Main Street in Coventry Township when she drove over the marked lane on the side of the road, striking three teens. 14-year-old Taylor Galloway of Akron, and 14-year-old Amber Thoma of Coventry Township, died. A 15-year-old was hospitalized with serious injuries.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Paul Gallagher is scheduled to sentence Boggs on June 15, 2018 at 9am.
