Akron Man Pleads Guilty in Connection with Making Illegal Fireworks

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, June 29, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Paul Plazak, 52, of Chalker Street in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the discovery of illegal fireworks in his home as police investigated a report of domestic violence.

Plazak pled guilty to the following charges:

- Domestic Violence – a felony of the 3rd degree
- Illegal Manufacture of Fireworks – a felony of the 3rd degree

On May 4, 2016, Akron police responded to Plazak's home on Chalker Street for a report of a domestic violence incident. Upon arrival, Officers were directed to the home's basement, where they discovered over 1,000 homemade fireworks. The bomb squad was called to help secure the scene.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Paul Gallagher is scheduled to sentence Plazak on August 10, 2016 at 10am.
