Tallmadge Man Indicted in Death of Akron Teen

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, April 28, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a Summit County Grand Jury has indicted Charles Queer, 63, of Woods Drive in Tallmadge, in connection with the death of 17-year-old Patricia Powell.

The Grand Jury indicted Queer on the following charges;

- Two counts of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide – felonies of the 2nd degree
- Three counts of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence – misdemeanors of the 1st degree

In the early morning hours of Sunday March 27, 2016, Patricia Powell was driving on I-76 east when her vehicle broke down. While she was alongside her disabled vehicle on the side of the road, another driver slammed into the back of Powell's car, killing her.

Queer is scheduled to be arraigned in Summit County court on Friday, April 29, 2016
