REPEAT VIOLENT OFFENDER SENTENCED FOR DRUG POSSESSION AND ASSAULT

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, March 10, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh today announced that visiting Judge H.F. Inderleid, Jr. sentenced Edwin Cain, Jr. to 8 years in prison.

Last month, a Summit County jury found Cain guilty of felonious assault, a second degree felony, carrying a concealed weapon, a fourth degree felony, and drug possession, a fifth degree felony. Cain is also a repeat violent offender.

In June of 2013, Cain was hanging out with a 35 year old woman at a home on Talbot Street in Akron, when the two began to argue. Cain then pushed the victim off a banister. She fell one story and broke her leg and ribs. Cain was eventually arrested in September of 2014, where officers found drugs and a concealed weapon.
