Sharrieff Isaiah Sentenced to 16 Years in Prison

AKRON, OHIO - November 26, 2014 - Summit County Prosecuting Attorney Sherri Bevan Walsh today announced that Judge Paul Gallagher sentenced Sharrieff Isaiah, 21, of Wilson Street in Akron, to 16 years in prison.

On October 22, 2014, Isaiah pled guilty to Aggravated Robbery, a felony of the $1^{\rm st}$ degree, with a three year Firearm Specification and Having a Weapon While Under Disability, a felony of the $3^{\rm rd}$ degree.

On February 26 2014, Isaiah pulled out a gun and demanded money from Church's Chicken on Main Street. Later that day, Isaiah went to a Family Dollar Store located on the same street and pulled out the same gun demanding money.
