Tallmadge Man Pleads Guilty to Secretly Recording Women in Bathroom

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, September 16, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Paul Strebler, 33, of Norton Drive in Tallmadge, pled guilty to setting up a recording device in a restaurant bathroom.

Strebler pled guilty to the following charges:

- Two counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity Orientated Material both felonies of the second degree
- Seven counts of Voyeurism misdemeanors of the first degree

Strebler was the manager of a local pizza restaurant and the district manager at several other shops. Strebler set up a hidden camera in the bathroom of the restaurant and recorded several of his female employees, some of whom were under the age of 18 at the time. Strebler fled to Arizona and was eventually arrested by National Park Service Rangers at the Grand Canyon.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Lynne Callahan is scheduled to sentence Strebler on November 18, 2015 at 2pm.
