Akron Man Pleads Guilty in Connection With Deadly Shooting

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, August 04, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Terry Tart, 38, of Doty Drive in Akron, pled guilty in connection with a shooting which left an acquaintance dead.

Tart pled guilty to the following charge:

- Involuntary Manslaughter with a Gun Specification – a felony of the 1st degree

In the afternoon of August 7, 2015, Tart and Marcus Glover forced their way into the Akron home of David Hillis and attempted to rob Hillis at gunpoint. When Tart and Glover ran off, Hillis opened fire with his own gun. Glover was about 70 yards away and no longer on Hillis' property when he was shot in the head and died.

Visiting Judge Richard Reinbold is scheduled to sentence Tart on September 7, 2016, at 11am.

David Hillis is charged with manslaughter with a gun specification and is scheduled to go on trial on August 16, 2016.
