Man pleads guilty to Craig's List Robbery

(April 20, 2010 Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Terrance Miller, 29, of Akron, pled guilty today to Aggravated Robbery with a gun specification, a felony of the first degree. He was sentenced to six years in prison by Judge Lynne Callahan.

On December 24, 2009, Miller and a 17-year-old female juvenile agreed to sell a computer to a man from Cincinnati. Miller had given the victim an abandoned house address in Akron. When the victim arrived to see the computer, the two put a gun to his head and robbed him of his wallet, which contained credit cards and the \$1,100 that was intended to purchase the computer. They threw the victim's keys outside and told him not to get them for a while. The two left him in the house and proceeded to use the credit cards for a Christmas shopping spree. Miller and the juvenile were tracked down and eventually arrested.

The juvenile also pled guilty today in Juvenile Court and agreed to testify truthfully against Mr. Miller had the case gone to trial.
