Terrence Minor Sentenced to Life in Prison for Aggravated Murder

(March 9, 2012... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Judge Tom Teodosio today sentenced Terrence Minor, 28, of Carroll Street in Akron, to life in prison for the murder of Demetrion Wilson.

On September 18, Minor drove to Day Street in Akron with the intent of fighting his girlfriend's brother. When Minor got to Day Street, he fired a gun over the roof of his car toward another brother of his girlfriend, Demetrion Wilson, striking him in the chest and killing him. Then Minor and two unknown male accomplices drove away. Minor was found by police hiding under a bed in Cleveland.

After less than an hour of deliberations on February 8, a jury found Minor guilty of Aggravated Murder with a gun specification, Murder with a gun specification and Having Weapons Under Disability. Minor will be eligible to apply for parole in 2041.
