Akron Woman Pleads Guilty to Fentanyl Related Death

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, April 13, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Elizabeth Ulrey, 37, of Upson Street in Akron, pled guilty to providing fentanyl to a person who later died.

Ulrey pled guilty to the following charges:

- Involuntary Manslaughter a felony of the 1st degree
- Corrupting Another with Drugs a felony of the 2nd degree

In April of 2015, Ulrey sold 28-year-old Reggie Dernbach fentanyl, which she obtained from her drug dealer. Dernbach took the fentanyl and later died after emergency crews made several attempts to revive him.

Ulrey is scheduled to be sentenced on May 18, 2016 at 10:15am.
