Winners of 2019 Safety Kids Calendar Announced

Annual Event Sponsored By Summit County Prosecutor's Office

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, October 30, 2018) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today the winners of the 2019 Safety Kids Calendar contest. Of the over 1,200 posters submitted from 17 different schools, Jaylee Greenwell's entry was chosen as the grand prize winner. Jaylee's poster, which advises kids to say No To Unwanted Touch showed tremendous creativity and her artwork was phenomenal.

This is the first time in the event's 17 year history we have had a person win the grand prize in back to back years. Last year Jaylee's poster urging kids to stay away from alcohol was on the front cover of the 2018 calendar. Jaylee was also a first place winner for the 2017 calendar with her anti-smoking poster.

Prosecutor Walsh, along with emcee Tim Daugherty from WONE-FM, presented the 54 winners with congratulatory certificates and Amazon gift cards on Monday, October 29, 2018, in front of a packed audience of family, friends, teachers and poster judges. The evening started with an A cappella rendition of the national anthem sung by the Miller South School Choir.

My "Prosecutor's Picks" added their own style and humor to the competition. The judges had a very difficult time choosing from the more than 1,200 entries. The grand prize and first-place winners and their posters will also be included in a PSA with Prosecutor Walsh that will air on WBNX-TV: The CW during the holidays.
