## **Akron Man Guilty of Cooking Meth**

(February 6, 2013... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a jury found Daniel Mack, 38, of Kenmore Blvd in Akron, guilty of Manufacturing Methamphetamines, a felony of the second degree; Illegal Assembly of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Methamphetamines, a felony of the third degree; and Aggravated Possession of Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree.

Acting on an anonymous tip in early October 2012, Akron Police went to an apartment in a four-unit building on Kenmore Blvd. where it was believed the tenants were cooking meth. Officers found in the apartment meth residue and ingredients and equipment used to manufacture meth. Evidence and testimony from Mack's landlord, a tenant and Akron Police officers revealed that Mack had been using and cooking meth in the apartment for months.

Judge Tammy O'Brien will sentence Mack on February 21 at 1:30 p.m.
