Akron Man Sentenced in Connection with Meth Lab

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, November 09, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Nicholas Anton, 25, of Mogadore Road in Akron, pled guilty to several charges in connection with making methamphetamines.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Todd McKenney immediately sentenced Anton to three-and-a-half years in prison.

Anton pled guilty to the following charges:

- Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs – a felony of the third degree
- Aggravated Possession of Drugs – a felony of the fifth degree

Anton was arrested on August 2, 2015, after Akron Police were called to Kimlyn Circle Apartments for reports of a 1-year-old walking alone and eating charcoal. Officers arrived and found several adults asleep in the apartment, as well as a meth lab, a small amount of the drug and syringes.
