Summit County Prosecutor's Office Launches "Arrive Alive" Program Campaign to Help Keep Drunk Drivers Off The Road

AKRON, Ohio (Friday June 29, 2018) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today a new anti-drunk driving campaign to help keep Summit County roads safe by providing free rides for the July 4th holiday for people who've had too much alcohol to drink.

Arrive Alive provides free rides up to a \$65 dollar fare for anyone in Summit County who has had too much to drink while celebrating the July 4th holiday.

"I feel this is extremely important to help keep our streets safe. For years I have fought to keep drunk drivers off the road," said Prosecutor Walsh.
