Cuyahoga Falls Teen Sentenced in Child Pornography Case

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, November 30, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Amy Corrigan-Jones sentenced Timothy Bergeron, 19, of Stow Avenue in Cuyahoga Falls, to four years in prison.

Bergeron was also designated a Tier II sex offender, meaning he will have to register with the local sheriff every six months for 25 years.

On November 2, 2015, Bergeron pled guilty to the following charge:

- Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor – a felony of the second degree

Bergeron downloaded pictures and videos of young children engaging in various sex acts. The youngest victim in these images was six-years-old. The Internet Crimes Against Children task force investigated and uncovered the downloads.
