Two Men Sentenced to 7 Years for Stabbing & Beating Another Man

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, April 16, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Ronny Bolding, age 48, and William Campbell-Stubblefield, age 20, were both sentenced to seven years in prison in connection with the stabbing of a man on Super Bowl Sunday.

On April 1, 2015, Bolding and Campbell-Stubblefield both pled guilty to attempted murder, a felony of the first degree, for stabbing the 66-year-old victim in the neck. The two also beat the victim in the head and threw him out of a car in the middle of an intersection during a robbery attempt. The incident occurred on February 1, 2015 in Norton. All three men had been drinking alcohol at the time.

Both apologized during sentencing in Judge Lynne Callahan's courtroom.
