Guilty for man who manufacturered meth

(Akron, September 7, 2010) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Charles Williams, 26, of Barberton, was found guilty by a jury on Friday of Illegal Manufacture of Drugs, a felony of the first degree, Illegal Assembly of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs, a felony of the second degree, and Endangering Children, a felony of the third degree.

Williams will be sentenced by Judge Paul Gallagher on October 12, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.

On March 19, 2010, the Narcotics Unit from the Cuyahoga Falls Police Department executed a search warrant for a home in Cuyahoga Falls. The Narcotics Unit found multiple items consistent with a Meth Lab.

The homeowner, Kristen Buck, 36, who is a co-defendant in the case, was arrested after dropping her child off at school. Her trial is scheduled for September 14, 2010, also in Judge Gallagher's court.
