Man pleads guilty to ten burglaries

(August 4, 2010 Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Danny Williams, 21, of Magnolia Avenue in Akron, pled guilty to ten counts of Burglary (felonies of the second degree).

Danny Williams, along with co-defendant, Robert Peters, committed a rash of burglaries all over Summit County between March 23 and April. These burglaries occurred in Akron, Bath, Tallmadge, Barberton, Green, and Stow/Munroe Falls. He additionally committed one burglary in December of 2009. After being caught on April 7, Williams confessed to his crimes. Williams and Peters waited until the victims left in the morning, and then broke into their homes. All occurred approximately between 9:00 a.m. and noon. Items commonly stolen were flat-screen TV's, computers, laptops, video game consoles, jewelry, and other miscellaneous items.

Williams is scheduled to be sentenced on September 8, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in front of Judge Stormer. Co-defendant Peters is currently set for trial on September 9.
