Akron Man Sentenced to Mandatory 26 Years in Prison for Violent Robbery

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, March 28, 2018) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Christine Croce sentenced Davon Irvine, 24, of Copley Road in Akron, to 26 years in prison for a violent armed robbery and kidnapping. Irvine is not eligible for judicial release and must serve the entire prison sentence.

On March 9, 2018, a Summit County Jury convicted Irvine of the following charges:

- Two Counts of Aggravated Robbery with a Gun Specification – felonies of the 1st degree
- Aggravated Burglary with a Gun Specification – a felony of the 1st degree
- Two Counts of Kidnapping with a Gun Specification – felonies of the 1st degree

On December 31, 2015, Irvine and another person broke into an Akron area home and tied up the two occupants. Irvine stole \$1,200 from the victims. Police are still searching for the second person involved in the crime.

Irvine was on judicial release and serving two years of community control at the time of the incident. Irvine pled guilty in September of 2013 to Felonious Assault, Possession of Cocaine, and Improperly Handling Firearms in a Motor Vehicle and served 18 months of a three year prison sentence.
