Akron Man Pleads Guilty in Connection with Teen's Heroin Death

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, July 20, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that James Foreman, 20, of Homestead Street in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the heroin death of 18-year-old Krista Barker.

Foreman pled guilty to the following charges:

- Involuntary Manslaughter – a felony of the first degree
- Trafficking in Heroin – a felony of the fifth degree

On December 26, 2014, Munroe Falls Police found Krista Barker dead from heroin. It was determined Foreman sold the heroin to Barker.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Amy Corrigan-Jones is scheduled to sentence Foreman on August 31, 2015 at 1 pm.
