Akron Man Sentenced for Trading Nude Photos with Under-Aged Teens

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, October 27, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Tom Parker sentenced Daniel Forshey, 36, of Farmdale Road in Akron, to 10 ½ years in prison.

Forshey was also designated a Tier II sex offender. Once he is released from prison, Forshey will have to register with the local sheriff every six months for 25 years.

On September 11, 2015, Forshey pled guilty to the following charges:

- Two Counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity Oriented Material or Performance– felonies of the second degree
- Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor a felony of the second degree
- Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor a felony of the fourth degree
- Three Counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity Oriented Material or Performance felonies of the fifth degree

In March of this year, Forshey admitted to investigators he had been exchanging sexually explicit photos and videos with young teens through his 'KIK' social media account. Forshey also admitted to sending nude pictures of juvenile family members to trade for images of child pornography.
