Akron Man Pleads Guilty in Deadly Shooting

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, August 17, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that David Hillis, 22, of Hilbish Avenue in Akron, pled guilty to shooting to death Marcus Glover following an attempted robbery at Hillis' home.

Hillis pled guilty to the following charge:

Voluntary Manslaughter – a felony of the 1st degree

In the afternoon of August 7, 2015, Hillis was at his Hilbish Avenue home when Terry Tart and Marcus Glover forced their way into the home. Tart and Glover attempted to rob Hillis at gunpoint. When Tart and Glover ran off, Hillis opened fire with his own gun. Glover was about 70 yards away and no longer on Hillis' property when he was shot in the head and died.

Tart pled guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter in connection with the incident on August 4, 2016.

Visiting Judge Richard Reinbold is scheduled to sentence Tart on September 7, 2016 at 11am and Hillis on October 7, 2016 at 10am.
