Akron Man Sentenced in Connection with Deadly Shooting

David Hillis to Serve One Year in Local Jail

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, November 16, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that visiting Judge Richard Reinbold sentenced David Hillis, 22, of Hilbish Avenue in Akron, to six years in prison.

Judge Reinbold suspended the sentence and placed Hillis on five years' probation. As a condition of the probation, Hillis must first serve one year in a local jail.

On August 17, 2016, Hillis pled guilty to the following charge:

- Voluntary Manslaughter – a felony of the 1st degree

In the afternoon of August 7, 2015, Terry Tart and Marcus Glover had an altercation with David Hillis at Hillis' Akron home. After the confrontation, Tart and Glover ran off. Hillis then opened fire with his own gun. Glover was about 70 yards away and no longer on Hillis' property when he was shot in the head and died.

On August 4, 2016, Tart pled guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter in connection with the incident. On October 26, 2016, Judge Reinbold sentenced Tart to nine years in prison.
