Akron Man Pleads Guilty to Murdering Grandmother

Nathan Huff Immediately Sentenced to Life In Prison

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, October 24, 2017) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Nathan Huff, 25, of Wilbur Avenue in Akron, pled guilty to stabbing his grandmother, 70-year-old Lena Cline, to death.

Huff pled to the following charge:

• Murder – a special felony

Visiting Judge James Kimbler immediately sentenced Huff to Life In Prison. Huff will be eligible for parole after serving 15 years.

In the early morning hours of November 11, 2016, Huff was alone with his grandmother Lena Cline at her Akron home. Huff then stabbed Cline 20 times, killing her.
