Man sentenced for killing brother

(March 11, 2009, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Akil Gay, 30, of Bacon Street in Akron, was sentenced by Judge Lynne Callahan to **10 years** in prison for Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, a felony of the first degree; Felonious Assault, a felony of the second degree and Driving Under the Influence, a misdemeanor of the first degree. Gay pled guilty to the charges on February 13, 2009.

Akil Gay and his brother Adika Gay had been drinking and got into an argument while at the family home. The argument ended up outside where Akil ran over his brother with an SUV. Adika was hospitalized for his injuries but died ten days later.
