Man found guilty of robbery

(September 3, 2009, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Kevin Moultry, 38, of Akron, was found guilty today by a jury of Robbery, a felony of the third degree. He was found not guilty of Petty Theft, a misdemeanor.

He will be sentenced by Judge Gallagher on October 26 at 9:00 a.m.

On May 28, 2009, Moultry stole jeans from a store on S. Arlington Road. He returned to the store on June 1, and again tried to steal a stack of jeans when the owner's mother tried to stop him. Moultry shoved her and took off running. A witness, who owned the store across the street, tackled Moultry and was able to get the jeans back, but Moultry got away.

Moultry was finally arrested on June 12, when the police were called because he was spotted nearby.
