Akron Man Pleads Guilty to Murder

AKRON, Ohio (Friday, May 14, 2021) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Christopher Blouir, 30, of Reed Avenue in Akron, pled guilty to shooting 30-year-old Isaiah Chapman to death.

Blouir pled guilty to the following charges:

- One Count of Aggravated Murder with a Gun Specification a Special Felony
- Two Counts of Murder with a Gun Specification a Special Felony
- One Count of Felonious Assault with a Gun Specification a Felony of the 2nd degree
- One Count of Carrying a Concealed Weapon a Felony of the 4th degree

On April 7, 2020, Blouir shot and killed Isaiah Chapman outside a home on Reed Avenue in Akron.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Alison McCarty is scheduled to sentence Blouir June 25, 2021 at 1pm.
