Akron Man Sentenced to LIFE IN PRISON for Rape

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, May 2, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Susan Baker Ross sentenced Robin Stevens, 40, of Oberlin Street in Akron, to LIFE IN PRISON, for the rape of an 11-year-old girl he knew.

Stevens will be eligible for parole after serving 16 years of his sentence.

Judge Baker Ross also designated Stevens a Tier III sex offender. As a Tier III sex offender, Stevens, if he is released from prison, would have to register with the local sheriff every 90 days for the rest of his life.

On April 4, 2022 a Summit County jury found Stevens guilty of the following charges:

- Rape – a Felony of the 1st Degree
- Attempted Rape – a Felony of the 1st Degree
- Two Counts of Gross Sexual Imposition – Felonies of the 3rd Degree

In 2019, the 11-year-old was staying at Stevens' house when he sexually assaulted the girl.
