Stow Man Sentenced to LIFE IN PRISON Without Parole for 2020 Murder

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, June 9, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Alison McCarty sentenced Terrian Wray, 22, of Meadowlark Trail in Stow, to LIFE IN PRISON WITHOUT PAROLE for the 2020 murder of Dee’Arius Reese.

On April 19, 2022 a Summit County jury found Wray guilty of the following charges:

- One Count of Aggravated Murder with a Gun Specification – a Special Felony
- Two Counts of Murder with Gun Specifications – Special Felonies
- Two Counts of Felonious Assault with Gun Specifications – Felonies of the 2nd Degree
- One Count of Having a Weapon Under Disability – a Felony of the 3rd Degree

On October 22, 2020, Wray shot Dee’arius Reese several times in the walkway leading up to a home on McMillan Circle in Akron. Wray and Reese were involved in an argument prior to the shooting. A second person, a 24-year-old female, was also shot and survived.

This was the second trial for Wray. A mistrial was declared on August 31, 2021 when jurors could not come to a consensus on a verdict.
