Smithville Man Sentenced to Prison for RV Rampage

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, June 23, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Randy Schiffbauer, 25, of Wadsworth Road in Smithville in Wayne County, was sentenced to 7-to-9.5 years in prison for stealing an RV and leading law enforcement on a chase through Summit County.

Prior to sentencing, Schiffbauer pled guilty to the following charges:

- Robbery – a Felony of the 3rd Degree
- Two Counts of Felonious Assault – Felonies of the 1st Degree
- Two Counts of Felonious Assault – Felonies of the 2nd Degree
- Failure to Comply – a Felony of the 3rd Degree

Schiffbauer also pled guilty to Receiving Stolen Property, a felony of the 4th degree, in an unrelated case.

On June 2, 2021, Schiffbauer stole a motorhome and led law enforcement on a chase on Interstate 77 through Akron. Schiffbauer eventually exited the highway at Arlington Road and continued driving erratically, striking several vehicles and up on sidewalks and lawns. Schiffbauer continued through Akron streets until officers deployed stop sticks and were finally successful in stopping Schiffbauer, who got stuck on a lawn at a home on Maplewood Drive.
