# Winners of 2023 Safety Kids Calendar Announced

Annual Event Sponsored By Summit County Prosecutor's Office

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, November 7, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today the winners of the 2023 Safety Kids Calendar contest, the 22<sup>nd</sup> year of the contest.

For the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic, the ceremony was held in-person at the Akron-Summit Library on South High Street. Of the over 1,000 submissions from 10 different schools in Summit County, the grand prize winner was 13-year-old **Emmah Cottrill**, a 7<sup>th</sup> grader at Springfield Junior High School. Emmah's creativity and artwork on "Don't Do Drugs" told the story that drugs take away everything that you love.

The awards ceremony was held on Wednesday evening, November 2, 2022. Summit County Prosecutor's Office Community Outreach Prosecutor Tania Nemer, along with Keith Kennedy from Akron's 98.1-FM, hosted the event for the 53 winners and their families. Also, a special thank you to the Miller South School Choir for singing the National Anthem and "Lift Every Voice and Sing" at the event.

I truly am so impressed with their dedication to making these outstanding depictions of my 12 safety rules," said Prosecutor Walsh. "Thank you to everyone who participated.
