Summit County Jury Finds Akron Man Guilty of 2020 Murder

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, November 15, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a Summit County jury found Kashmair Mingo, 23, of Nestor Avenue in Akron, guilty in connection with the 2020 murder of 21-year-old Tyraye Carter.

Jurors found Mingo guilty of the following charges:

- Murder with a Gun Specification a Special Felony
- Aggravated Robbery with a Gun Specification a Felony of the 1st Degree
- Obstructing Justice a Felony of the 3rd Degree
- Having a Weapon Under Disability a Felony of the 3rd Degree

On December 3, 2020, 21-year-old Tyraye Carter was shot several times while sitting in his car in the area of Tampa Avenue and 28th Street Southwest in Akron. Investigators were able to identify three suspects, Kashmair Mingo, 21-year-old Javion Rankin of Balch Street in Akron, and 23-year-old Donrell Davis of Eller Avenue in Akron.

Co-defendants Javion Rankin and Dorell Davis are charged with the following:

- Aggravated Murder with a Gun Specification a Special Felony
- Two Counts of Murder with Gun Specifications Special Felonies
- Aggravated Robbery with a Gun Specification a Felony of the 1st Degree

Rankin is also charged with Having a Weapon Under Disability – a Felony of the 3rd Degree

Rankin is scheduled to go on trial January 16, 2023. A trial date for Davis has not yet been scheduled.

Visiting Judge Edward O'Farrell is scheduled to sentence Mingo December 30, 2022 at 10a.
