Akron Teen Pleads Guilty to Killing Man on Akron Metro Bus

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, November 28, 2022) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Kavon Jackson, 18, of Euclid Avenue in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the shooting death of 21-year-old William Howell.

Jackson pled guilty to the following charges:

- Murder with a Gun Specification – a Special Felony

In May of 2021, Kavon Jackson, who was 17-years-old at the time, got into an altercation with William Howell on an Akron Metro bus at the bus transit center in downtown Akron. During the argument, Jackson shot Williams ten times. Williams died later at the hospital. Akron Police captured Jackson after a short chase.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Christine Croce is scheduled to sentence Jackson on December 6, 2022 at 10am.
