Akron Man Sentenced to Prison for Causing Crash Which Killed Passenger

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, May 8, 2023) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Joy Oldfield sentenced Kenny Clinton, 37, of Marcy Street in Akron, to seven years in prison for causing a 2021 crash which killed 24-year-old Keera Bradley.

On February 16, 2023, Clinton pled guilty to the following charges:

- Aggravated Vehicular Homicide a Felony of the 3rd Degree
- Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of Police Officer a Felony of the 3rd Degree
- Failure to Stop After an Accident a Felony of the 4th Degree

In October of 2021, Clinton was driving with Keera Bradley on Marcy Street in Akron when he drove off after being pulled over by police. Clinton eventually crashed into a dumpster on Andrus Street near Steiner Avenue. Keera Bradley died in the crash. Following the crash, Clinton ran off and called police to report his car was stolen. Using DNA, investigators were able to determine Clinton was driving the car at the time of the crash.
