Winners of 2024 Safety Kids Calendar Announced

Annual Event Sponsored By Summit County Prosecutor's Office

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, November 13, 2023) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today the winners of the 2024 Safety Kids Calendar contest, the 23rd year of the contest.

The ceremony was held in-person at the Akron-Summit Library on South High Street. Of the over 1,000 submissions from 10 different schools in Summit County, the grand prize winner was 13-year-old **Isabella Elmiger**, a 7th grader at Green Middle School. Isabella's creativity and artwork for the "Don't Use Alcohol" category said "think, don't drink" and posed a choice between water and alcohol. Isabella's poster will be on the front cover of the 2024 Safety Kids Calendar!

The awards ceremony was held on Wednesday evening, November 8, 2023. Summit County Prosecutor's Office Community Outreach Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich, along with Keith Kennedy from Akron's 98.1-FM, hosted the event for the 53 winners and their families. Also, a special thank you to the Miller South School Choir for singing the National Anthem and "Lift Every Voice and Sing" at the event.
