Akron Man Sentenced to LIFE IN PRISON for Deadly Shooting

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, November 29, 2023) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Alison Breaux sentenced Mohamed Serour, 24, of Newton Place in Akron, to LIFE IN PRISON for shooting LaDaviere Davis to death in May of 2021.

Serour will be eligible for parole after serving 16 years of his sentence.

Prior to sentencing Serour pled guilty to the following charge:

- Murder with a Gun Specification – a Special Felony

On May 25, 2021, 20-year-old LaDaviere Davis was shot and killed inside his North Valley Street home in Akron. Eight months later Akron Police pulled Serour over and found he was in possession of the gun used to shoot Davis. Investigators also determined the car Serour was driving was in front of the victim's home at the time of the murder.
