Akron Man Indicted in Connection with Assault at Summit Metro Parks

AKRON, Ohio (Friday, August 23, 2024) – Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced today a Summit County grand jury indicted Issac Armour, 32, of West Lowell Avenue in Akron in connection with an assault at the Summit Metro Parks on August 13, 2024.

Armour is charged with:

- Kidnapping a Felony of the 1st Degree
- Attempted Rape a Felony of the 2nd Degree
- Abduction a Felony of the 3rd Degree
- Two Counts of Gross Sexual Imposition Felonies of the 4th Degree

"This was a violent attack and my office will work hard to hold this offender accountable," said Prosecutor Kolkovich. "I also want to thank the three good Samaritans who came to the victim's rescue and helped capture the suspect." At around 9 a.m. on August 13, 2024, three people ran to a woman who was screaming for help along Cuyahoga Street near Trailhead in the Summit County Metro Parks. The three found 33-year-old woman being attacked and assaulted by a man. The three were able to get the man off the woman, with one hitting the man with a rock. The victim later told police that she had just left the bathroom when she was grabbed from behind and assaulted.

Armour's next court appearance has not yet been scheduled.
