## Cleveland Woman Sentenced to LIFE IN PRISON for Murder of Hudson Man

AKRON, Ohio (Thursday, September 19, 2024) – Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Alison Breaux sentenced Terreionna Paschal, 32, of East 188<sup>th</sup> Street in Cleveland, to LIFE IN PRISON for the murder of Todd Morgan in April of 2023.

Paschal will be eligible for parole after serving 23 years of her sentence. As a result of her guilty plea, Paschal was placed on the state's violent offender registry.

On Wednesday, September 18, 2024, Paschal pled guilty to the following charge:

Aggravated murder with a Gun Specification – a Special Felony

"Todd Morgan was a beloved member of our community. Todd was a loving father, husband, and son as well as a mentor to many. This is tragedy will be felt for years to come," said Prosecutor Kolkovich. "This community is safer as a result of this sentence. Thank you to the Hudson Police Department and the assistant prosecutors on this case."

In April of 2023, Paschal shot and killed Morgan at his Hudson home. The two only knew each other for a limited time prior to the shooting. Through phone records, mobile apps, DNA, and ballistics, Hudson detectives were able to link Paschal to Morgan and placed her at his home at the time of the murder.
