## Akron Man Sentenced to LIFE IN PRISON for 2022 Murder

AKRON, Ohio (Monday, October 28, 2024) – Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced today that retired visiting Judge James Kimbler sentenced Antonio Miller, 27, of Taggart Drive in Akron, to LIFE IN PRISON, for the 2022 murder of Tina Case.

Miller must serve 36 years of his sentence before being eligible for parole.

"Antonio Miller is a dangerous person who ambushed a beloved mother while she sat in her car. He deserves to spend the rest of his life behind bars. My hope is today's sentence brings some justice and peace to Tina Case's family," said Prosecutor Kolkovich.

On September 23, 2024, a Summit County jury found Miller guilty of the following charges:

- Aggravated Murder with a Gun Specification an Unclassified Felony
- Two Counts of Murder with Gun Specifications Unclassified Felonies
- Felonious Assault with a Gun Specification a Felony of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree

On April 7, 2022, 50-year-old Tina Case was shot and killed while in her car outside of her Koerber Avenue home in Akron. At the time Miller and Case's daughter had broken up following a five-year on-and-off relationship. Investigators arrested Miller five months later after security camera video linked him to the crime.
