Of the over 1,000 submissions from 13 different schools in Summit County, the grand prize winner was 13-year-old **Makayla Craig**, an 8<sup>th</sup> grader at Nordonia Middle School. Makayla's creativity and artwork for the "Don't Give into Peer Pressure" category said "it's boring to be like everyone else" and showed different types of leaves. Makayla's poster will be on the front cover of the 2025 Safety Kids Calendar!

The awards ceremony was held on Wednesday evening, November 13, 2024, at the Akron-Summit Library. Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich hosted the event for the 54 winners and their families and presented congratulatory certificates and Amazon gift cards. Also, a special thank you to the Miller South School Choir for singing the National Anthem and "Lift Every Voice and Sing" at the event.
