PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES CONVICTION OF MAN WHO ATTACKED FRIEND WITH A MACHETE

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that a jury found Jimmy J.R. Armstead, 41, guilty of one count of Felonious Assault – a 2nd Degree Felony – for attacking his friend with a machete last year.

"Jimmy Armstead senselessly and violently attacked someone who trusted him. I want to thank the first responders who were able to provide the victim with the medical care and transportation he needed," said Prosecutor Kolkovich. "I also want to thank the Akron Police Department and my assistant prosecutors for their work to hold Armstead accountable."

Last June, the victim was at Armstead's house. Armstead was highly intoxicated, and when the victim asked Armstead for \$20 that he owed him, Armstead attacked the victim with a machete. The victim sustained wounds to his face, hand, and chest.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Susan Baker Ross is scheduled to Sentence Armstead on March 18, 2025 at 1:00 p.m.
